- **Schedule Changes-fall 2009-** As a result of discussions with the school district, we are changing the schedule of our school day. SCS will use a 4 period Block schedule. School will begin at 7:45 and end at 3:00. Class length will be 1 hr 30 minutes. We feel that these changes will benefit all our students and parents by providing a longer school day, more elective choices and schedule flexibility. Transportation will be provided to and from school under a contract arrangement with LPOSD 84. Students will ride to and from school with students from other schools, including students from Sandpoint High School. Buses will pick up SCS students at our school, rather than using a transit bus. Please note that *busing on some routes may be subject to seat availability*. Sandpoint Charter School will make a good faith effort to provide busing; however SCS is not required to provide transportation services and receives no funding for transportation.
